Lead Counsellor Position Description

Qualifications:

- At least 17 years of age for Junior and Junior High Camps.
- At least 20 years of age for Youth Camps.
- Leading an exemplary Christian life in behaviour, attitudes and conduct prior to camp.
- Agreement with the Camp's *Statement of Faith*

Accountability: Director(s)

Abilities:

- Cooperative, willing to work under supervision, and willing to abide by the rules.
- Enjoy being with children in a cabin setting.

Responsibilities:

- a) Assist the Director(s) in seeking to carry forth the Camp's objectives within the lives of the campers.
- b) Lead a consistent Christian life before all campers and serve as a positive role model in speech, actions, attitudes and attire.
- c) Seek to lead campers to personal faith in Jesus Christ and help them grow in their Christian life.
- d) Suppress personal prejudices, problems and opinions and show no partiality or favouritism to any individual or group.
- e) Live in the cabin with the campers assigned to him or her.
- f) Get to know each camper personally by spending time individually with him or her.
- g) Seek the safety of the campers.
- h) Be responsible for the discipline of his or her group. In case of serious problems, discuss the matter with the Director(s) and pursue the recommended course of action.
- i) Report missing campers to the Director(s) immediately.
- j) Monitor physical well-being of campers, e.g. sufficient rest, cleanliness, and changing clothes.
- k) Report any health problems to the Nurse.
- l) Teach and supervise lessons assigned to him or her.
- m) Encourage camper participation in cabin and all camp activities.
- n) Organize and lead daily devotions with the cabin group.
- o) Seek to build up each camper's self worth, facilitate relationships between campers and encourage a high level of morale.
- p) Interpret the rules, policies and traditions of the Camp to the campers and obtain camper cooperation with same.
- q) Implement informal programming with the cabin group during free time.
- r) Supervise and encourage any Associate Counsellors assigned to the cabin.
- s) Complete all evaluations and forms as requested by the Directors(s) or Camp Board.
